She is a creative and thorough handler, trainer, and instructor and teaches upper-level handling classes at A Click Above in Leesburg, VA, as well as private lessons and seminars throughout the country. Carrie has successfully competed with three dogs Tango (JRT), Twist (JRT), and Jive (BC). All of her dogs have earned their MACH and ADCH titles and competed at national events in AKC and USDAA. She has been a multi-time Steeplechase and Grand Prix finalist at USDAA Nationals. At AKC Nationals, she has made multiple appearances in the finals and challengers round, as well as class winner in individual rounds. Her most recent accomplishments have been with Jive -- 2008 AKC National Champion, 2008 Crufts International Agility Final Round Winner, 3-time AKC World Team Member (2006-Switzerland, 2007-Norway, 2008-Finland), 2007 USDAA National Dog Agility Masters Team Champion, 2007 FCI World Championship Large Team Silver and 6th Individual Large Overall.
