From Hartford CT take I-84E to I-384E. Take exit 7 from I-384 to CT-85 S for Bolton Center Road. Turn right on Bolton Center Road. Drive 1.9 miles on Bolton Center Road. At stop sign by Bolton Town Hall/Congregational Church, bear left onto Bolton Center Road, at intersection of Bolton Center Road and Hebron Road. Rose Farm is 1st driveway on left.

From the intersection of Routes 6W and 44W stay in RIGHT lane, bear to RIGHT and take exit US6/44W towards Bolton – DO NOT GET ON I-384. At stoplight turn left onto CT-85S/Bolton Center Rd for 2.3 miles. Stay straight on Bolton Center Rd. ENTRY FEE: \$75 for Tracking Dog and \$150 for Tracking Dog Excellent which includes AKC recording fee and service fees. Checks payable to LEAP Agility Club.

CLOSING DATE: 6:00 p.m. Thursday, March 19, 2026 at the Test Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted.

As required by the AKC Tracking Regulations, a written certification must accompany the TD entry for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD test.

**All entrants submitting certifications should enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope so that unused certifications may be returned.**

In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the Tracking Regulations, the Test Secretary may enter and handle a dog that she owns or co-owns.

In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17d, 1 track in the TDX test will be offered to an entrant using Worker Credits.

SUBSTITUTION OF TRACKS: In the event that there are insufficient TD or TDX entries, tracks may be substituted using the factor of 2 TDs = 1 TDX as specified in Chapter 1, Section 15 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

The drawings for entries and alternates will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. This TD /TDX Test is open to all breeds.

The random drawing will take place at Red Rose Pizzeria 1060 Main St, Springfield, MA 01103 at 6:30 pm on Thursday, March 19, 2026 or as soon as practicable thereafter. After the entry limit is reached in either TD, or TDX, an alternate list will be prepared with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entries of the results of the draw by e-mail as soon as practicable after the draw.

WITHDRAWALS: Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary. If an entry withdraws for any reason between the closing date and the test date and is replaced by an alternate, the entry check will not be used, however, if the entrant is not replaced by an alternate the check will be used. The entry check for an alternate that does not participate will not be used.

**ENTRY FEES WILL BE MADE BY CHECK. If you would like your check returned in the event it is unused, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope; otherwise all such checks will be shredded.**

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations after all other dogs and bitches have been tested. They will be allowed on the tracking fields only immediately prior to the running of their tracks. Please notify the Test Secretary as soon as you know your bitch is in season for this test.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. **INSTRUCTIONS**

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
