Stacy Peardot-Goudy is an agility veteran whose dogs have earned the entire alphabet soup of agility titles (O-NATCH x 2, ADCH x 7, MACH2, GM, RM, SM, JM, U-AG I, U-AG II, etc.). Stacy has qualified for the USDAA Grand Prix of Dog Agility the last 11 years in a row, and finished in 4th place in the 26" height division of the 2000 USDAA Nationals with Secret. Stacy and Secret were once again finalists in the 2003 Grand Prix World Championships as well as the 2001 and 2002 Grand Prix World Championships.

This seminar is designed with serious sequencing in mind and will test both handler and dog on difficult configurations.

SAT JAN 30 • Nov/Open level - dogs must be doing all equipment and be able to complete a 12-15 obstacle course. This session will focus on building the necessary skills for advancement to the next level for both dog and handler. In both sessions, we will also explore short sequences and exercises that will help improve timing and efficiency.

SUN JAN 31 • Excellent/Masters level will push the envelope on lead outs, keep you on your toes with level of difficulty and push you to think through tough spots for the answer that best fits you and your dog.
